## **STEP 1: REGISTER ON PRIMARY HEALTH**

## H2: STEP 4: UNDERSTAND YOUR RESULTS

#### POSITIVE

#### NEGATIVE

If you feel well and have no COVID-19 symptoms, return to school/work!

If you have symptoms, please stay home until you have been fever-free for 24 hours and your symptoms have significantly improved.
