Subject: Consolidated Application 2016-17 Winter Report						

The Consolidated Application is an online report/application that is used by the California Department of Education (CDE) to distribute federal program funds including Title I (for Increasing Student Achievement of Low Income/Low Performing Students), Title II (for Improving Teacher Quality) and Title III (for Supporting Limited English Proficient and Immigrant Students). In addition, the Consolidated Application serves as a way for CDE to monitor the use of federal funds and compliance with federal and state regulations.

The Consolidated Application is submitted by the district two times a year, in February (Winter Report) and June (Spring Report). Each Consolidated Application submission consists of many reports, mostly financial, indicating the districts' progress in spending federal funding. Since each federal funding source has a 27 month grant cycle, the Consolidated Application contains reports spanning 3 years. Reporting may include information such as explanations of the use of funds, the number of students receiving academic interventions and the funding utilized, and a list of non-profit private schools that receive Title I and Title II funded services from the district.

The Winter Report submitted in the consent agenda, reports the amount of Title I, Title II and Title III funding allocated for the current year. Of particular interest are the Title I pages, which show the LEA allocation and how funding is utilized in the district and distributed to schools. This report also indicates the amount of funding utilized for services to non-profit, private schools.

Subject: Transitional Kindergarten Waiver to Comply with Education Code 37202: Equity Length of Time						

Education Code 37202: *Equity Length of Time* requires that school districts that offer extended day kindergarten classes that also have a Transitional (Early) Kindergarten class seek a waiver if both classes do not have matched instructional minutes.

Applying for a waiver will grant shorter instructional minutes for the Early Kindergarten programs which serve students who are beginning school at ages 4 and 5. SCUSD is applying for a waiver in two schools that have unmatched minutes due to an extended kindergarten program. The two impacted schools are Washington Elementary and Tahoe Elementary.

Subject: SCUSD Teacher Induction Approval of Sponsorship						

SCUSD has been an accredited program provider of the Beginning Teacher Support and Assessment (BTSA) provider, as approved by the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing (Commission), since the enactment of AB 2042 in 1998, which established the BTSA program state-wide. In October, 2016, the Commission adopted a new single set of Teacher Induction (Induction) Program Standards intended to address the needs of all teacher candidates regardless if they were seeking a Clear General Education credential, or an Education Specialist credential. These new standards were also the result of the continuing effort of the Commission to refocus Induction on ensuring a highly individualized, mentoring-based, job-embedded program for new teachers to provide them with the mentoring needed to support the refinement of their practice.

With the adoption of the new Induction Program Standards, school districts that were previously BTSA providers are now required to make adjustments to re-align their program to meet and implement the requirements of the new standards by September 1, 2017. In school-year 2015-16, school districts were also required to develop a transition plan that outlined program attributes that would need to be modified to ensure the new Induction Program was on track to meet the new Induction Program Standards.

SCUSD is presently piloting the new Induction Program developed per our transition plan. As an additional part of the process to demonstrate conformation to the new Induction Standards, districts are required to submit a *Preconditions Report* to the Commission by March 31, 2017. Precondition 1 of the report requires that the district submits verification of the governing board's sponsorship of the Induction program as part of the ongoing transition process of meeting the accreditation requirements towards the new Induction Program standards. The request is therefore for the Board to approve sponsorship for SCUSD to serve as an Induction Program.
