This year, 1300 students at 9 SCUSD schools are participating in *Link Up!* an orchestral music program for students in grades 3-5, sponsored by Carnegie Hall. The program is in schools across the country. SCUSD students will play in the culminating performances which are at the Sacramento Community Center Theater (1301 L Street, Sacramento, CA 95814) on Friday, April 7, at 10:15 and 11:35 a.m. SCUSD schools are split between the 2 performances. At each performance, 2300 students from the Sacramento area will perform together with the Sacramento Philharmonic and Orchestra. This year's theme is The Orchestra Moves. Carnegie Hall provides the curriculum, and school districts provide the recorders and the transportation to the final performance. Classroom teachers attend training, and work with their students over the course of the school year to learn the program which includes singing, playing recorders or playing string instruments.
