Subject: California Classified School Employee Teacher Training Program - UPDATE						

The Human Resources Department is pleased to announce participation in a consortium with surrounding districts and Sacramento County Office of Education (SCOE) that will help support current SCUSD classified employees interested in becoming a teacher.

As you may recall, the goal of the program is to create a bachelor degree-credential pathway, the program will allow employees to continue to work while attending evening and online courses. The highlight of the program is it offers fiscal resources (\$4,000/per year/per participant) to help alleviate the financial burdens of pursuing a degree and a teaching credential. The grant intends to offer assistance for books, fees and tuition.

The district will have a total of 12 SCUSD employees participating in this program. Five are eligible to enter our classrooms this Fall as SCOE interns (because they already have an undergraduate degree) and seven employees will enroll in classes to complete their undergraduate degree and continue through the program for up to 5 years working towards obtaining both their degree and teaching credential.
