Subject: School Illness Update						

Student Support and Health Services is continuing its proactive job on the school illnesses that have erupted at Elder Creek, Caroline Wenzel and Rosa Parks and working with Facilities and Communications to manage and monitor the situation. The Norovirus has not been confirmed at the three schools, but students or staff have experienced suspicious symptoms.

Staff is working with the county health department and has taken the following action, per the county's directive:

1. Sending letters to all students at Rosa Parks, Caroline Wenzel and Elder Creek along with the CDC Norovirus Fact Sheet. The fact sheet was given to MOC this morning and translated quickly so it could accompany the letters to parents today.
2. Schools will track illnesses of any students or staff exhibiting gastrointestinal (GI) symptoms on an Excel Spread Sheet form provided by the county.
3. Richard Remund and his team will perform Deep Cleaning at all three schools today or over the weekend.

Saturday school was cancelled at Rosa Parks to allow for the deep cleaning to occur, including a computer lab where student testing occurred.

We will keep you informed if new developments occur.

Subject: Teacher Recruitment for 2017-18						

Interviews were held from April 3 - 5 in the Philippines for the purpose of recruiting special education teachers. Over 70 candidates were interviewed. The interview panel made up of Daniel McCord, Principal of Crocker/Riverside, Jake Hansen, Personnel Specialist, and Michael Kast, Special Education Supervisor and 9 teachers were recruited. These teachers are expected to arrive late July and ready to teach for the opening of our schools.

This year, we continued our partnership with U-CAN (United College Action Network). Our partnership helped to facilitate visits to 14 HBCU (Historically Black Colleges and Universities) campuses. We are anticipating 12 teachers joining us this year.

Sac State faculty in collaboration with SCUSD staff completed the interview process to select candidates to participate in the Dual Credential Program Cohort. The panel selected 11 candidates to work in SCUSD (Multiple Subjects/Special Education) for 2017-18, while taking the required courses from Sac State to obtain their teaching credential within 2 years.

We are excited to welcome and congratulate them for joining the SCUSD team! A special welcome and celebratory event will be scheduled. More information to come.
