Subject: Father Keith B. Kenny/City of Sacramento Library Partnership						
<p>SCUSD has been approached by City Councilman Jay Shenirer about exploring the possibility of a shared-use library on the Father Keith B. Kenny school site. Currently there is no library in the Oak Park area. Although a free-standing library would be ideal, funds are not available to construct one at this time. Mr. Shenirer would like to convene a workgroup to study the possibility of a joint-use facility. The library (including the books, technology, and librarian) would be used by both students and the community. The library would require some physical changes (at the city's expense) to provide services to all patrons while at the same time maintaining the safety of all students and adults on the campus. This partnership would promote literacy and help develop school readiness of neighborhood children. To date, no commitments have been made by either party. Both parties have agreed to continued efforts exploring this proposed joint-use arrangement.</p>
