## BP 3515.3

## **Business and Noninstructional Operations**

To help ensure the safety of district staff and students and the security of real and personal district property, the Governing Board may establish and maintain an agreement with the City of Sacramento and/or the Sacramento County Sheriff Department that assigns officers to work within the school district boundary on a full time basis.

The Police Officers/Deputy Sheriffs assigned to the district shall provide foot and vehicle patrol and other security protection services on school campuses as agreed upon between the district and the providing agency. The Police Officers/Deputy Sheriffs may issue citations or make arrests for crimes committed on school campuses, write reports as directed by the district, and other related duties.

Agreements with the local law enforcement shall provide that Police Officers/Deputy Sheriffs conduct themselves in ways that promote good will and cooperation on the part of students, district staff, and the general public.
