Drug And Alcohol Testing For Employees In Safety Sensitive Positions

BP 4312.42 4112.42,4312.42

Personnel

The Governing Board desires to take all possible steps to ensure transportation safety for district students and staff. The Superintendent or designee shall establish a drug and alcohol testing program for all school bus drivers and any other employees who hold a commercial driver's license and work in safety sensitive positions which is necessary to perform duties related to their employment with the district. This program shall be designed to fulfill the requirements of federal law and regulations.

Employees who test positive for alcohol or drugs shall be removed from safety-sensitive functions and subject to disciplinary action up to and including dismissal in accordance with administrative regulations.
