Challenging Courses By Examination

BP 6155 Instruction

The Governing Board recognizes that there is a need to allow high school students to challenge a given course by examination for grade and credit in order to accelerate progress towards graduation and to achieve more flexibility in the selection of electives. This opportunity will permit a student to enroll in courses best suited to his/her educational objectives.

The examination shall be comprehensive and cover all course objectives. Successful completion of the examination shall be at a level, which indicates mastery of the content and/or reasonable chance for success in the next higher course. Students successfully completing the challenge examination for a given course will receive a grade and credit for that course.
