The attachment provides the Title I final allocations for the 2019-20 school year. Please note that the last column, *Title I Adjusted Net*, reflects positive balances. There are no changes for Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF), Free/Reduced (F/R) and LCFF – Limited English Proficiency (LEP).

The funding per pupil allocated to the schools increased by approximately \$3.74 as of the latest data available in comparison to the funding amount from the initial projections. The maximum carryover for Title I will be ten percent (10%) of the final allocation per school for all schools. The school sites are expected to spend their current allocation on their current students.

Please review this data with the appropriate school site committees. Funds need to be allocated for school improvement activities as indicated in your School Plan for Student Achievement.

Please Note: There will be no carryover for Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF) from the 2019-20 school year into the 2020-21 school year.
