### Smarter Balanced

- ❖ <http://www.smarterbalanced.org>
  - Click on Smarter Balanced Assessments bar (at top) – *do **not** use drop-down list*
    - Scroll down, look under “Item/Task Specifications”
      - Look under “Mathematics.”
        - Click on “Mathematics Grades \_\_\_\_ (ZIP).”
          - Open or Save the file to your computer
