

ELIGIBILITY:

Graduating McClatchy seniors who will attend a two- or four-year college or university in the fall of 2018 are eligible.

Applicant should have:

- 3.0 or greater GPA;
- Commitment to continuing his or her education;
- · Financial need.

The application process requires:

- Completion of the application form, which includes an essay that will help us get to know you and

 and activities, volunteer work, paid work, family, responsibilities at home, and the financial
 importance of receiving a scholarship;
- An unofficial transcript:
- 2 letters of recommendation (see directions on website for submission guidelines);

April 4, 2018

SELECTION PROCESS:

GPA is only one determining factor. Consideration will also be given to the applicant's demonstrated commitment to their interests and passions, community service, plans to give back to the community in the future, and financial need. The awards committee will read and evaluate all applications. The committee may, at its discretion, have phone or in-person interviews with the candidates.
