

Who is Included in the English Learner Student Group?

California's accountability and continuous improvement system is called the California School Dashboard. It provides information about how districts and schools are meeting the needs of California's diverse student population based on a concise set of measures.

The Dashboard shows performance of districts, schools, and student groups on a set of state and local measures that assist in identifying strengths, weaknesses, and areas in need of improvement.

Who is included in the English learner student group for each measure?

Students included in the English learner (EL) student group vary by measure. The table below displays which students are incorporated in the EL student group for each measure.

Measure	Who Counts as an EL?
Academic Performance	Students who are marked as EL during the time of testing, including students who were reclassified (or RFEP) within the past four years (i.e., reclassified <i>after</i> April 15, 2014).
Chronic Absenteeism	Students who are marked as an EL at any time during the 2017–18 academic year.
College/Career Readiness	Students who are marked as EL at any time during the four-year cohort, or the Dashboard Alternative School Status (DASS) graduation rate, for the Class of 2018.
English Learner Progress	Results for students who took the Summative English Language Proficiency Assessments for California (ELPAC) will be reported on the 2018 Dashboard.
Graduation Rate	Students who are marked as EL at any time during the four-year cohort, or the DASS graduation rate, for the Class of 2018.
Suspension Rate	Students who are marked as an EL at any time during the 2017–18 academic year.
