Proposition 39 was a ballot initiative approved by California voters in 2000 that requires school districts to provide charter schools' in-District students with facilities that are "reasonably equivalent"



District's Obligations

- Reasonably Equivalent - Quantity and Quality
- Contiguous Facilities
- Furnished and Equipped



Facilities Request Timelines

Action	Deadline (dates are from the year prior to the school year facilities are provided)
School must submit facility request	On or before November 1
District's preliminary offer of facilities	On or before February 1
School must respond to preliminary offer	No later than March 1
District's final offer	No later than April 1
School must reply to district offer	No later than May 1
