The selected student must submit an online application and supporting documents no later than Friday, April 16, 2021.

## **ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE WINNER:**

The Mayor, City of Sacramento, and the Superintendent (or designee), Sacramento City Unified School District, will announce the winner of the George H. Clark Scholarship at a meeting of the Sacramento City Council. The student and his/her parents/guardians will be invited to attend this meeting.

## **APPLICATION ATTACHMENTS:**

Any student who meets the stated qualifications must complete an online application. The completed application must be accompanied by the following documents:

- <u>Two Letters of Recommendation</u> (MUST INCLUDE):
  *Letters from <u>outside the school</u>* (i.e. employer, pastor, youth leader, or community leader)
- 2. <u>Student Letter Addressed to Trustees, George Clark Memorial Scholarship</u> (MUST BE TYPED and 750 words or less):
  - Describe your educational and vocational goals (short-term **and** long-term)
  - How you plan to use the scholarship funds
- 3. <u>Transcript:</u>
  - An unofficial transcript of student's high school record, including the first semester grades of your senior year
- 4. <u>College Enrollment</u>:
  - Verification of acceptance to a University of California institution or acknowledgement by the university that the process is underway
