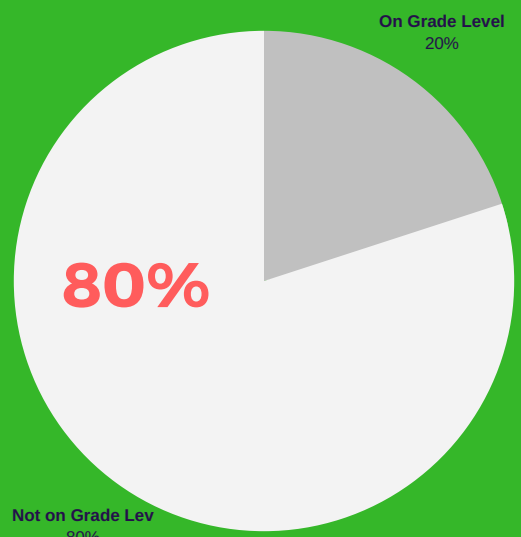
Students not reading proficiently by 3rd grade are 4x more likely to drop out.

Over 2,000 current Sac City Unified high school students need credit recovery.
