Background/Rationale: In accordance with the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) Act of 2001, school districts that have failed to meet Title III Annual Measurable Achievement Objectives (AMAOs) for two or four consecutive years are required to submit an action plan to the California Department of Education.

The ultimate aim of the plan is for the school district to make systemic changes in areas of concern in order to assure achievement of AMAO targets. The plan describes modifications to the EL program, including interventions, method of instruction, and assessment strategies designed to support the improvement of learning for English learners.

The District English Learners Advisory Committee (DELAC) and site-based personnel have reviewed the plan and provided input.

Financial Considerations: The Title III Action Plan represents approximately \$2,800,000.00 in categorical funds for Sacramento City Unified School District, used to supplement curriculum implementation and instructional practices, as well as support personnel, professional learning, and teacher stipends.
