## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING Between SACRAMENTO CITY UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT And

SACRAMENTO CITY TEACHERS ASSOCIATION
Concerning ROTC Instructors

The Sacramento City Unified School District hereinafter called the "District," and the Sacramento City Teachers Association, hereinafter called the "Association" and collectively referred to throughout this Agreement as the "Parties," hereby agree to the following terms and conditions:

## Recitals

Whereas, ROTC instructors are part of the bargaining unit represented by the Association;

Whereas, the ROTC instructors petitioned SCTA for a unit modification and that after considering and investigating the petition request, the SCTA Board determined to approve the request;

Whereas, the Parties agree that the ROTC instructors do not share a community of interest with the bargaining unit;

Now, therefore, for and in consideration of the mutual promises, the Parties agree that ROTC instructor and programs and language will be removed from the bargaining unit and all contractual agreements represented by the Association.

Now, also is attached a true copy of the signed petition by the ROTC instructors seeking separation from the SCTA Bargaining unit and contractual agreements.
