**Recommendation:** Approve Resolution No. 2700: Resolution in Support of Statewide Education Funding Initiatives

**Background/Rationale:** If neither of the statewide education funding initiatives, Schools and Local Public Safety Protection Act (Brown initiative) and Our Children Our Future: Local Schools and Early Education Investment Act (Munger initiative) qualify for the November ballot or are not approved by a majority of the voters, the District's deficit for next year is estimated to be a minimum of \$43 million which will include personnel and program reductions, increased class sizes, and the elimination of sports, yearbook, drama, cheerleading, newspaper, speech and debate activities.

**Financial Considerations:** The impact to the budget would be mitigated by the passage of either or both of these funding initiatives which is estimated to reduce the District's deficit shortfall to approximately \$28 million, depending on which of the funding initiatives is passed.
