The Child Development Department enrolls and serves 1,387 children within Head Start, Children’s Centers, Infant/Toddler, and Home Based Programs. Children ages 3-5 enrolled in the Head Start Program receive comprehensive services, including mental health and health screenings. Families are encouraged to enter into partnership agreements to set family goals. Goals include completing school, seeking new employment opportunities, nutrition education, and learning child development strategies. Early Head Start serves pregnant teens and children ages 0-3 years.
