Re: SCTA Alleged Conflict of Interest

Dear Mr. Borsos:

The District's October 21, 2020 letter provided a summary of the District's analysis of SCTA's allegation of a conflict of interest related to our expanded learning contracts. In response to your October 25, 2020 email, we do not share our legal advice as such is attorney-client privileged. Suffice it to say, however, that we were satisfied by the review of the matter from our internal counsel that concluded there was no conflict of interest present. My October 21<sup>st</sup> letter provided to SCTA a summary of this analysis and conclusion. As explained in some detail in the letter, Mr. Behrens has served as an unpaid volunteer board member in the non-profit 501(c)(3) community based organization and had no involvement at all with the District's entering into the expanded learning agreement at issue. As he had no economic interest in the agreement at issue, no conflict of interest existed and there was no need for any disclosures.

Because we are satisfied with the conclusion that no conflict of interest was present, there is no need for further action by the District at this time. Of course, you are free to pursue any course of action that you may deem necessary and appropriate.

We look forward to working with you productively to address the many critically important matters currently facing the District, specifically the safe reopening of our schools and our substantial budget challenges.
