GENERAL INFORMATION:

Jan Matisco worked at JFK from 1972 until she retired in June of 2009. During these four decades, she and her husband, Joe Matisco, touched the lives of many students at Kennedy. They spent countless hours dedicating their time to Kennedy and our athletes.

Former staff and alumni have come together to honor Jan and Joe by creating the Jan and Joe Matisco Student Athlete Scholarship. Each year, a Kennedy Senior who exhibits dedication to their academics and athletics will be awarded a scholarship in the Matisco's name.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE:

You must be a graduating senior, have at least a 3.0 GPA, be a student athlete, and be enrolled in college for the Fall of 2020 to apply. Please submit only one application. Include the following items in your application:

- A single page, typed letter about yourself. Please include how being a student athlete at Kennedy has prepared you for college
- Two letters of recommendation. One letter from a current teacher of your choice and one letter from a current Kennedy High School coach
- A current transcript

APPLICATION ATTACHMENTS:

Any student who meets the stated qualifications must complete an online application. The completed application must be accompanied by the following documents.

1. Two Letters of Recommendation (MUST INCLUDE):
Both letters must include a phone number and contact information, and if possible, should be on official letterhead.
 - One from a current Kennedy High School teacher; and***
 - One from a current Kennedy High School coach***
2. Student Essay (MUST BE TYPED):
Include a complete single-page essay about yourself. Please include how being a student athlete at Kennedy has prepared you for college
 - Single-page essay.***
3. Transcript:
 - An unofficial transcript of student's high school record, including the first semester of your senior year
