



Language Academy of Sacramento's Amended Application To The Charter School Facilities Program and Related Actions

In 2009, Language Academy of Sacramento (LAS) applied for the Charter Schools Facilities Program from the State Office of Public School Construction.

LAS was awarded funding from the Charter School Facilities Program in 2010:

- New Construction, \$6,662,240
- Rehabilitation, \$1,878,376

Unfunded due to State budget until February 2011.



LAS proposes:

Moving the State Facilities grant from Fruit Ridge to Marian Anderson



A Board Resolution

Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)

Facilities Use Agreement (Long Term)

Deadline for the State is July 6, 2011



Long Term District Agreements

- District agrees to allow LAS to rehabilitate the portables and build new facilities at Marian Anderson campus
- District agrees to allow LAS use Marian Anderson for the duration of their charter's existence.

Long Term LAS Agreements

- LAS agrees to incur approximately \$4.2 million loan from the State, which will be for 30 years.
- LAS agrees to use the District's custodial services
- LAS agrees to use the District's maintenance and operations services
- LAS agrees to collaborate with the District in developing an autism or other innovative program at Marian Anderson
