Overview



- Increase prices by 25 cents effective January 1, 2012
- Increase prices by another 25 cents effective July 1, 2012
- Paid lunch prices not increased since 2000
- Increased prices do not impact free or reduced lunch families



Comparison to Surrounding Districts



District	Elementary	Middle	High
Sacramento City	\$1.25	\$1.75	\$1.75
San Juan	\$2.75	\$3.25	\$3.25
Elk Grove	\$2.50	\$3.00	\$3.00
Natomas	\$2.25	\$2.75	\$2.75
Twin Rivers	\$2.10	\$2.25	\$2.50



Need for Increase



- Healthy Foods Task Force
 - Fresh and local food
- Additional costs to provide nutritionally improved food
- Nutrition Services Fund is self-supporting – does not encroach on the General Fund
