



# PANDEMIC-EBT

QUALIFY FOR \$365 DEBIT  
CARD FOR GROCERIES

## P-EBT FAQ

**Q: My child does not qualify for FREE/REDUCED lunches. Are they still eligible?**

**A:** Yes, if your child is enrolled in an SCUSD school, they qualify. All our SCUSD students are eligible for FREE breakfast regardless of income. During the P-EBT application process, when asked if your child receives FREE/REDUCED meals at school, the answer for SCUSD students is YES because all students are eligible for FREE breakfast

**Q: One of my children already received a P-EBTcard in the mail and the other child did not. What do I do?**

**A:** If the child is a student of SCUSD, go to [www.ca.p-ebt.org](http://www.ca.p-ebt.org) to apply for the other child

**Q: My 3 year old attends a preschool (state or head start) program at a SCUSD school. Is he/she eligible for the P-EBTcard?**

**A:** No. Only school aged students enrolled in a SCUSD schools are eligible

**Q: If I am unsure if my child attends a SCUSD school can I apply anyway?**

**A:** Yes. We recommend that anyone should apply online to see if they qualify

**Q: One of my children attends a school in another district. Will that child qualify?**

**A:** Go to [www.ca.p-ebt.org](http://www.ca.p-ebt.org) to apply to see if they qualify

**Q: My student is enrolled in Independent Study, or a homeschool program through SCUSD. Do they qualify?**

**A:** It depends. We encourage all families to apply, however some students enrolled in Independent Study, or homeschool programs may not qualify for P-EBT benefits

**Q: My student is not a permanent resident of the US. Do they still qualify for P-EBT funds?**

**A:** Yes, as long as they are a school aged student of SCUSD. Income and Social Security Information is not requested on the online application

**Q: How much money will I get? And how often will I receive payments?**

**A:** P-EBT is a one-time, \$365 payment for groceries for each school-aged child that qualifies

**Q: How long does it take to receive your P-EBT card after applying and qualifying?**

**A:** 12-14 business days

**Q: I have three children that qualify. Will I receive 3 debit cards?**

**A:** No. You will receive one debit card with the oldest child's name on it. The card will include funds for all eligible children on one debit card

**Q: When is the last day to apply?**

**A:** June 30, 2020

**Q: How long is the P-EBT card good for?**

**A:** The card is good for 1 year

**Q: Where can the P-EBT card be used?**

**A:** The P-EBT card may be used for groceries at most grocery stores, farmers markets, and on line at Amazon and Walmart.
