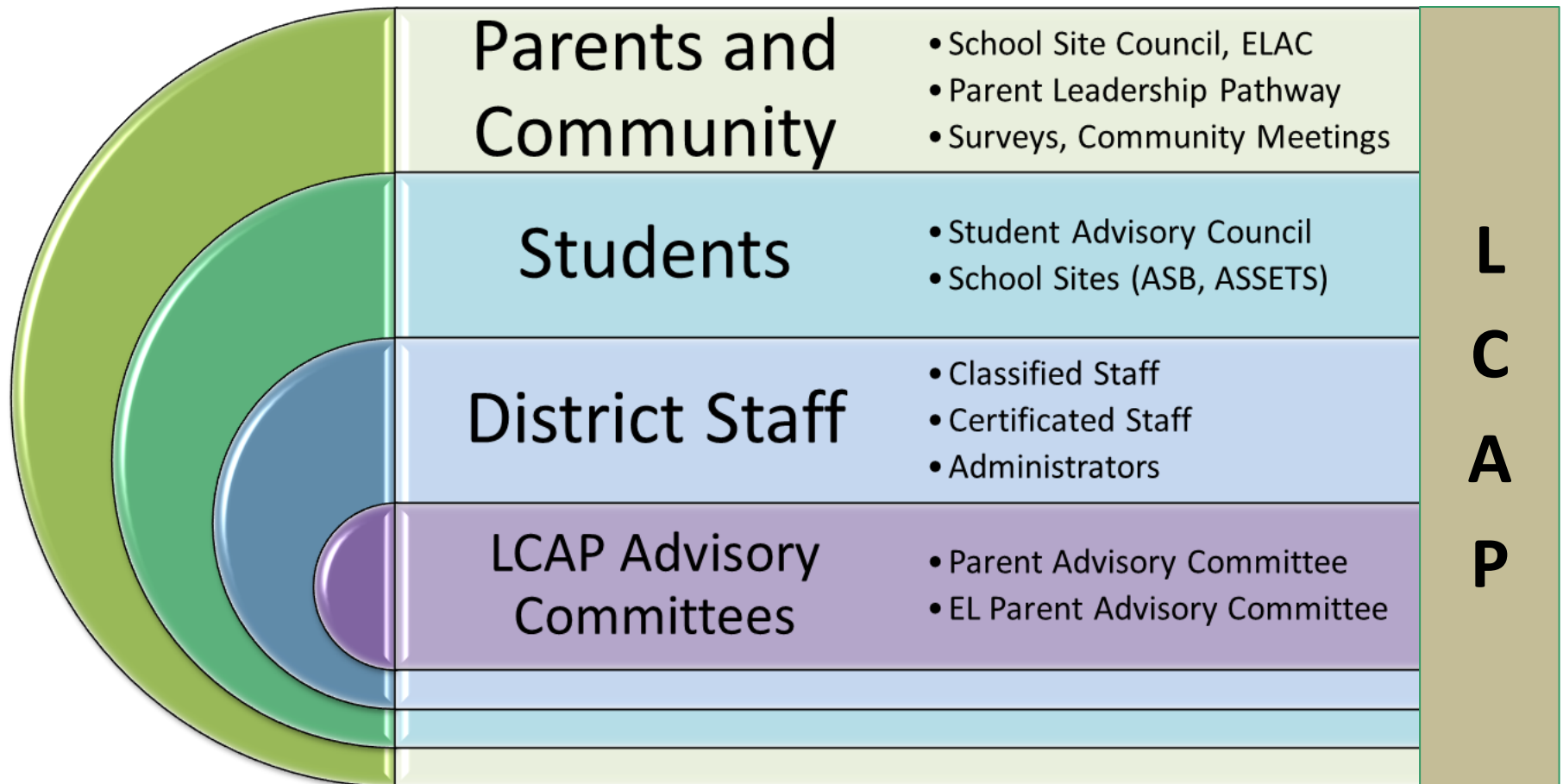
Responsibilities:
