



GET TESTED & STOP THE SPREAD

Sacramento City Unified School District (SCUSD) offers free and voluntary COVID-19 testing for all students and staff on a regular basis. We encourage everyone to participate in routine testing to limit the spread of COVID-19 and keep our community healthy and safe.

How to Register:

Rapid Antigen tests: Register once then just drop in to get tested. To register, point your camera at the QR code to the right or go to:

YOUR SCHOOL SITE'S TESTING EVENTS

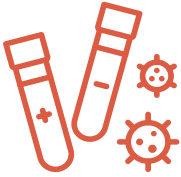
SCUSD school and work sites will offer COVID testing to registered students and staff. Schools will notify students and staff of testing dates.

Types of Tests:

PCR testing, widely used and known as the most reliable test. **Results are provided within 24-48 hours.**

Rapid antigen tests/BinaxNOW, provide results within 15 minutes, however any positive test results must be confirmed with a PCR test.

Both tests are self-administered

Individuals use a long soft cotton swab to gently circulate in each nostril. These tests are simple enough for children to do themselves with a person instructing and observing.



Parent & Minor Consent:

- Consent for routine COVID-19 testing is provided when you register your student for testing.
- **Parent/guardian consent is required for students under 13 years old.**
- **Students 13 years and older may register themselves** and provide consent for testing*.
- If a parent/guardian only wants to consent for testing one-time, please inform the Health Aide at the school site.
- If parents want to revoke consent for testing, please notify the school in writing.

Privacy and Security:



Personal health information and test results are confidentially stored in the software application. Your information and results will be shared with SCUSD Health Services, and with state and county agencies for public health contact tracing purposes. You may view COVID terms of service, Notice of Privacy Practices, COVID HIPAA authorization, and COVID informed consent to learn more.

* Cal. Fam. Code § 6920 et seq and Cal. Fam.
