

Report Card Dates

Month	Actions
December	A report card and a parent/teacher conference is required. The conference is normally held in person at the school site
March	A report card is required and a parent/teacher conference is optional. Either the parent or the teacher may request a conference at this time
June	A report card is required

How does a teacher determine my child's grades?

- Teachers at a grade level work together to determine assignments and assessments that are best for assessing students' understanding of the standards
- Teachers look at student work together to determine marks
