

## SCUSD Offers Free Whooping Cough Boosters

## <u>Immunization clinic on Wednesday is part of SCUSD's</u> <u>comprehensive preparations for new state law</u>

May 10, 2011 (Sacramento) – SCUSD is staging a series of free immunization clinics to help parents comply with a new California booster shot requirement.

State law now requires that all students entering seventh through 12<sup>th</sup> grades in the fall provide proof of receiving the Tdap (tetanus, diphtheria and pertussis) vaccination on or after age 7. **The proof must be recorded before students enter school in September, according to the law.** 

Parents of children currently in grades six through 11 who have not had the Tdap or the DTP (an earlier version of the vaccine) can bring their children to Luther Burbank High School (3500 Florin Road) auditorium from 4:30 p.m. to 7 p.m. on Wednesday, May 11 for a free inoculation. Parents must bring their child's immunization record to receive a booster shot.

Those clinics are scheduled from 4 p.m. to 6 p.m. on the following days and locations:
