NOTES:

A completed Universal Waste label must be taped to all Universal Waste boxes or containers.

All 4 foot and 8 foot used fluorescent straight lamps must be placed in the original box or in a recycle lamp box. Boxes must be completely closed, and sealed with tape to prevent tubes from falling out.

All other types of lamps must be placed in a closed box and sealed. Batteries must be placed in a 5 gallon pail.

Do not mix different types of lamps together or different category batteries together.

All Category 4 Lithium Batteries must have tape over the terminals.
