>	The following items will be checked DAILY in each classroom:													
	 □ Safety covers are in all open outlets. □ All potential poisons are stored in locked cabinet/out of reach of children (only labeled cleaning product – PH7Q may be stored on classroom shelf). □ Bathrooms are clean (hourly checklist completed). □ Food (except during meals) and diaper disposal cans are covered. □ Materials and toys are stored in a safe and orderly fashion. □ Adult handbags stored in locked cabinets. □ Pull-cords for blinds are out of reach of children and knot-free. □ Playground is free of trash, hazardous materials and unsafe conditions. 													
	 The following items will be checked/cleaned MONTHLY. First Aid Kits (classroom and field trip - initial inside lid) Disaster Supply Kit is available and complete. Fibar under play equipment is adequate. Refrigerator (temp. below 40 deg.), microwave, food warmers and carts are clean. Fire extinguisher is in good condition; meter is in green zone AND extinguisher has not expired.
