PATHWAY STUDENT OUTCOMES

Academic Core Classes: Titan Media curriculum is organically integrated into all content areas through hands-on, project-based learning. Students in our pathway have the opportunity to earn college credit through an articulation agreement with Cosumnes River College.

Technical Core: Titan Media students study and explore careers in the mass media and technology fields. In conjunction with the Media Arts and Technology Small Learning Community, we help to create the highly skilled problem-solvers needed for the media industry.

Work-Based Learning: Titan Media Production students get opportunities for their work to be shown on local television outlets such as Access: Sacramento channels 17 and 18 along with the Sacramento Educational Cable Consortium channels 15 and 16. Plus, they do public service announcements for many area non-profit organizations.

Student Support Services: There are systems in place that support students' academic, social and emotional needs. We are a part of the Media Arts and Technology Small Learning Community which supports students in developing exceptional study skills, setting graduation goals and planning for college and career. Students emerge from Luther Burbank, Media Arts & Technology SLC and Titan Media Productions, in particular, as highly functioning citizens, prepared to contribute to the global community.
