4.0 DEFINITIONS:

4.1 A hazardous spill is any chemical liquid or solid that can harm people or the environment.

5.0 PROCEDURE:

- 5.1 If a <u>small spill</u> occurs (i.e., fuel at the island) the shop spreads absorbent agent out to pick up the liquid and then disposes of the absorbent as solid hazardous waste.
- 5.2 If a <u>large spill</u> occurs, the shop personnel will dam the spill to prevent it from going into the storm water drains and call 911.
- 5.3 The Superintendents office will also be notified.
- 5.4 A report will also be included in that month's Storm Water Report.
